Carbon Monoxide Safety

- Carbon Monoxide - or CO - is a poisonous, colorless, odorless gas produced from burning fuels like gasoline, propane, natural gas or charcoal.
- Use gas-powered generators and grills OUTSIDE.
- Install carbon monoxide alarms on each level of your home. Change batteries twice a year, ususally when you change the time on your clocks each spring and fall.
